

Face mask pattern with pocket

Supplies:

15" x 7 1/2" of fabric

Bias tape 7" (for casing)

2 pieces of Elastic 9 3/4" or two 23" bias/twill tape strips

Start with 15" x 7 1/2" of fabric.

Serge or zigzag around the entire rectangle.

Fold in half wrong sides together (end with a 7 1/2" X 7 1/2" square)

Sew (1/2" seam allowance) top edge 1 1/2" in from left and right leaving an opening in the middle. Press open the seam.



Turn right side out.

Topstitch along seam line.



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Rotate/Fold over top ½ inch down to create pocket for filter and small pocket for twist tie or vinyl covered flexible wire to go thru.

Baste along sides.



With right side facing up create 3 pleats, using wonder clip and stitch edges down. Baste in place. The finished width should be about 3" wide.



Add a binding to the two edges to create casing.

Slide elastic through the casing and tie ends together. If you are using twill tape/fabric, slide it through casement. You can also sew tape/fabric directly to mask.
