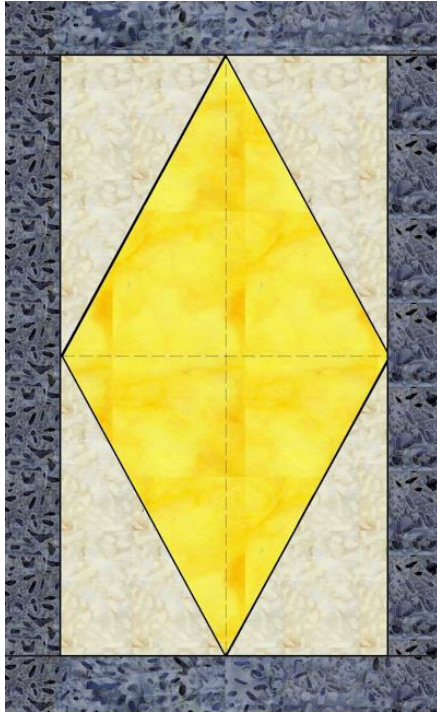
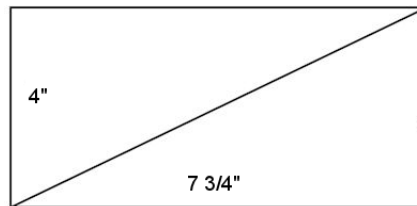
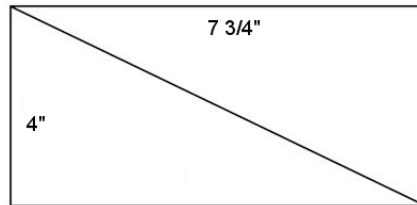


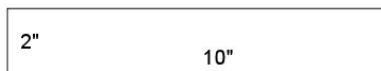
September 2019 – Diamond



Finished Block 6" x 12"
 6 1/2" x 12 1/2" Incl. Seam Allowance)

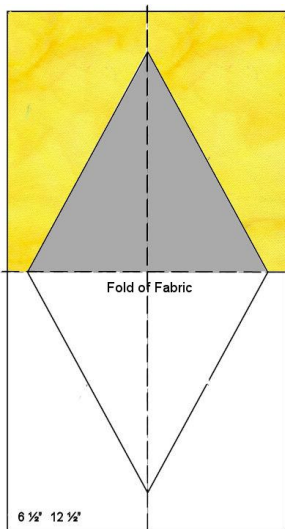


From your Light Background fabric, Cut
 2 4" x 7 3/4" rectangles
 Cut each of them diagonally once in opposite direction (Mirror Image). You will have four Triangles as shown on the left.



From your Dark background fabric, Cut:
 2 Strips 2" x 10"
 (Horizontal Borders)

2 Strips 2 1/2" x 11"
 (Vertical Borders)



From the Yellow fabric (the 7" x 13" fabric from the store) , Cut
 1 6 1/2" x 12 1/2" Rectangle

Print the Diamond-half template (shown in gray here) – The template is at the end of this document – and Cut out the Triangle. (Note: Ensure that the template is 100%. The small square on the page should be 1").

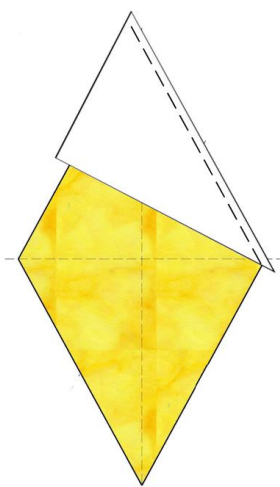
Fold the fabric in half as shown and Press the fold.

Align the Base-line of the Triangle with the fold of the fabric – and:
 Pin the Triangle to the fabric.

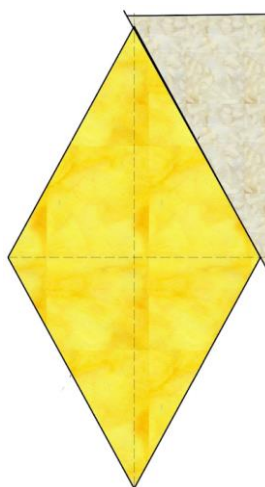
Cut the folded fabric along the diagonal sides of the Triangle.

Remove the template, open the fabric and Press the Diamond carefully.

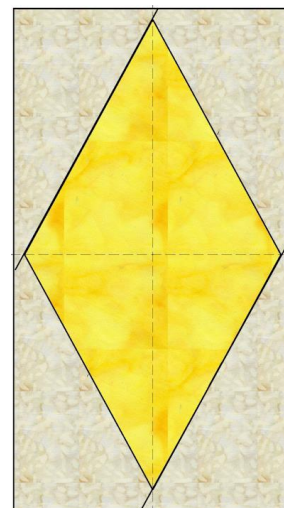
The diamond should be 5 5/8" x 11 1/4" (**INCLUDES SEAM ALLOWANCE**).



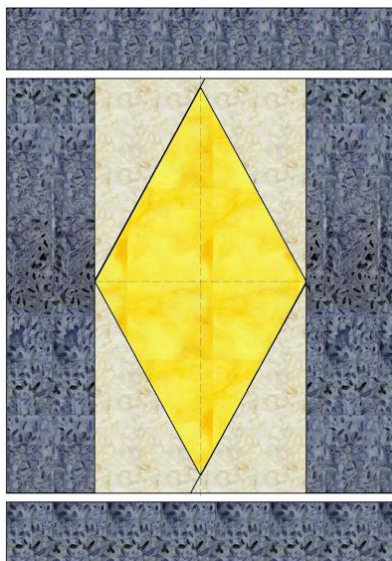
Taking the triangles that you cut from the light background:
Place ("center") one of them right-side on right-side onto your diamond and sew the two together with a 1/4" seam allowance.



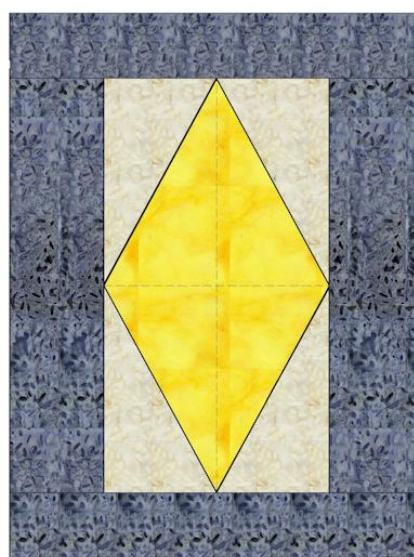
Flip and Press the triangle and sew the triangle to all four side.



Leaving 1/4" seam allowance, trim the rectangle (your center!) to 5 1/2" x 10 1/2".



Using your Dark Background fabric:
Add the Vertical borders first (2 1/2" x 11")
Then:
Add the Horizontal borders (2" x 10")



I recommend that you do NOT trim the block at this time. Wait until you know how things all fit together!
